Day 1 USA to Mazatlan

Day 2 Mazatlan, Sea of Cortez Snorkeling & Old Town



Day 4 Total Solar Eclipse



A flight will take you to the beach city of Mazatlan for a look at Old Town or a wonderful snorkeling adventure. We'll then drive up through the Sierra Madre to historic Durango. We will see the Total Solar Eclipse in the



"Pueblo Magico" of Durango, ride the tram, and explore museums.

There will also be talks on the eclipse and eclipse photography. Weather should be excellent for the eclipse, but cloud cover could obscure it. The expedition will be a delight for travelers with a sense of adventure. (No smoking during meals or lectures please.)



Costs:

- Per person twin share \$3,295 plus air fare to Mazatlan, with return from Durango (approximately \$995 from Dallas).
- Single Supplement \$595 additional. (Limited singles available.)


Expedition Fee Includes: Exploration by bus, vans, or tram; accommodations in first class hotels; most meals; group park and entrance fees; tips to drivers; leadership by an excellent Betchart naturalist; administration.

Expedition Fee Does Not Include: International air (quoted separately); airport transfers; tips to guides, and expedition leader; beverages at meals; optional activities; alcoholic beverages, snacks, sodas, bottled water, internet use, passport, travel insurance or other personal expenses.

Deposit: \$1,000 per person; final payment is due 150 days before departure (November 1, 2023).

Cancellation Penalty: Deposit is refundable less \$250 per person

until 150 days before departure. Within 150 days of departure, payments are nonrefundable. Trip cancellation insurance will be offered.
